Safety Tips for Pets



DECORS

- Avoid using candles. Use LED lights
- Anchor your Christmas tree or block it
- Artificial X-mas tree is the best
- Keep the gift wrappers out of your pup's eyesight
- No glass ornaments!



FOOD & DRINK

- Sweets and chocolates - NO! NO! NO!
- Do not feed bones - it may cause dental damage
- Choose pet-friendly foods
- Keep alcohol away from pets & children
- Do not toss any nuts as treats!



PLANTS AND TREES

- Holly, Mistletoe, Poinsettia, Christmas pine tree - dangerous
- They cause mouth irritation and gastric distress
- Sometimes these plants are fatal too!



GATHERINGS AND PARTY

- Educate your guests how to behave with your pet
- Isolate your pet from that place if he/she feels clumsy
- Have an eye on the children: Are they playing or disturbing your pet?
- Put on some potty pee pads where your pet spends much time
