Protect their paws

- Frigidness causes your pet's paws dry and cracked
- Use palm balm and moisturize
- · Wipe their paws off to remove ice, salt, or other tiny particles



- Dehydration occurs in winter
- Provide plenty of fresh water
- Add some low-sodium broth or ice cubes to their water bowl
