



COMMON PET FIRST AID PROCEDURES

Educating yourself about the basic emergency procedures and keeping a pet first aid handy can keep your pooch safe even if you are miles away from a veterinary center.

BEFORE TREATING YOUR PET

Secure them with a leash or a muzzle. This is not a question of their behavior but even the most docile of animals attack when in pain.



Cover your pet with a blanket. This is very important as it helps them feel safe and warm.

Encourage them to drink water. Pets do not understand if they are hydrated or not, and when stressed due to pain, the chances go down even further.



In case of wounds, clean the open skin with water and dab it with antiseptic on a clean cotton pad until the blood starts to blot.

In case of broken bones, it is best to put your pet on a flat surface like a plank of wood and secure the affected part with a towel or a blanket.

While giving first aid to your pet, the sessions must always have a veterinary follow-up.
