## 1. Overheating



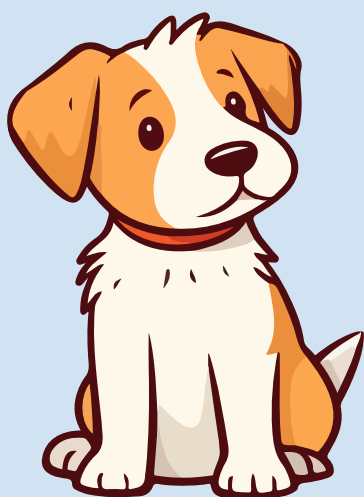
**Watch for Signs:** Excessive panting, drooling, and lethargy can indicate overheating.
