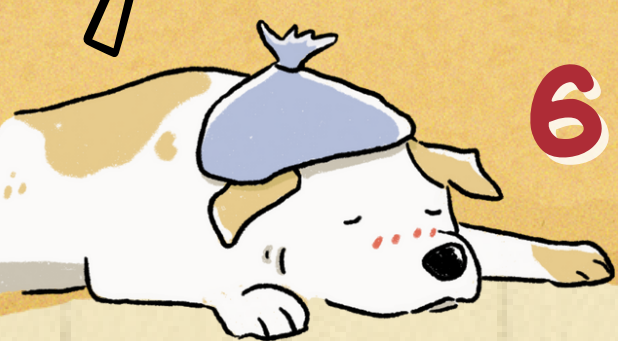
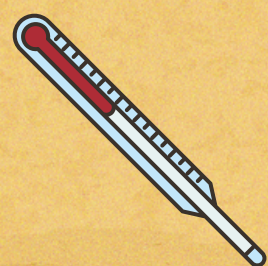
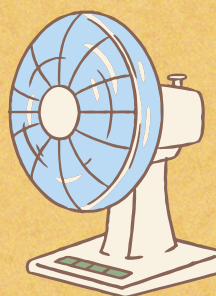


Heat stroke in dogs treatment at home

6 STEPS

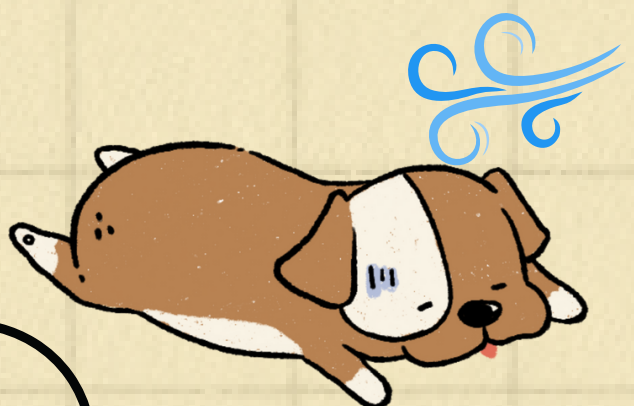


Do you suspect your dog is suffering from heat stroke?
Here are six steps you must follow

01

MOVE YOUR DOG TO A COOL AREA:

Bring your dog to a cool and ventilated area.



02

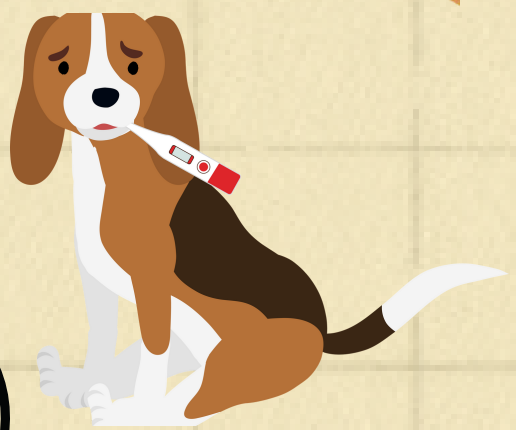
COOL YOUR DOG DOWN:

Use cool water to wet your dog's fur (Avoid using cold water/ice)

03

MONITOR TEMPERATURE

100.5°F to 102.5°F - normal
Above 104°F - continue cooling them down.



04

REHYDRATE YOUR DOG.

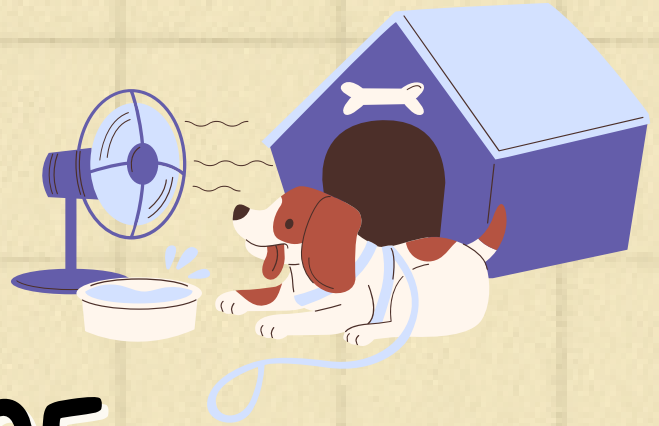
Offer Water/ice cubes to lick. You can also give a small amount of Pedialyte to replace lost electrolytes.



05

USE FANS

Air circulation aids in the evaporation of the water and lower their body temperature.

SEEK VET'S HELP

If your dog's condition does not improve within 10 to 15 minutes, go to your vet immediately.
