





HOW MUCH TO FEED A KITTY?



Kittens have unique nutritional needs. Feeding them appropriately ensures they develop into strong, healthy cats.



Up to 8 weeks:

It's a nursing period. Feed specially formulated kitten milk replacer if orphaned or weaned early.



2 to 3 months:

Wet food: Feed x4 times daily approx 1.5 to 4 oz per meal



3 to 6 months:

Feed x3 times daily. Gradually increase the feeding amount, typically between 3 to 5 oz.



3 to 6 months:

Feed x2 meals a day, just like adult cats. (4 to 6 oz per meal)
