

Is your *pet* **Chipped & Up-to-date?**



Losing a dog is Terrifying.

One in Three pets will become lost in their lifetime (source: Petfinder).



A microchip is an important tool to help your dog get home safely, especially if you travel with your dog in your RV or camper.



Uses RFID technology

Contains an identification number

Not a GPS unit and does not track the dog's whereabouts

Microchip

Scan this chip to get the pet owner's information using online databases

Pets are usually microchipped during their first visit with their veterinarian

Let's learn the benefits of microchipping your dog



Things to do

- Mention how to reach you** when you have limited access to mobile
- Use Google Voice** which you can also access from a public computer or landline
- Keep your contact information** current with the Microchip database
- Give your email** so you can be reached when you are unable to access your mobile

How to locate Chip Manufacturer Database?

Ask your veterinarian to scan your chip and give you the identification number.

Then search the **AAHA Universal Pet Microchip Lookup** to find out where you need to register your chip.

Companies such as **HomeAgain** and **AKC ReUnite** allow you to register your dog's microchip for a fee regardless of manufacturer.



What Next?

Keeping your pets from being lost is just one side, Use a pet temperature monitor and keep them **SAFE** too!
