Pet Vacation

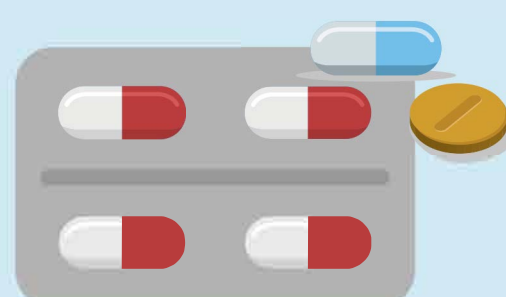
Pets add more fun and relaxation to your vacations

Don't forget these things before taking your dog on a vacation



Plan your trip at least a week in advance.

Pack basic **meds** prescribed by your Vet.



Check for the **weather** and **pet-friendliness** of the destination.

Planning a trek? Get a **travel water bottle** for your Fido.



Take your **dog's license**.
And other vaccination documents.

First time for your fur kid?
Take **short trips** for a week.



Seal proof the windows.
To prevent your dog hanging his head out.

Get a **pet barrier** attached to your RV/car.
Unrestrained dogs can cause accidents.



Have a **secondary collar**.
That has your name, address and phone number.

Get a **Pet T-shirt**. This protects your dog from infections.



Don't leave them alone in the RV/car. Use a **Pet Temperature Monitor** to alert you when your pet is unsafe.
