





RAPID PANTING

If you observe an abnormal pattern in their panting, particularly during summer, it may be a sign of heatstroke. If you plan to leave your pup behind in an RV/Car, even for a short while, install a **Waggle pet monitor** to get peace of mind.

BLOOD IN URINE

Do not take it lightly. A urinary tract infection could cause blood in the urine. Take your pet to a Vet immediately if you find blood in their urine.





EAR INFECTION

Ear infections are widespread in dogs. **Dogs in cold regions** are more prone to ear infections. Swelling of the ear's outer portion, lack of balance, vigorous scratching, and bloody discharge are some of the signs of ear infection.

SCRATCHING

Scratching is pretty common in dogs, but compulsive scratching is not!
One of the first signs is developing a "Hot Spot," which can occur anywhere in the body.





UPSET STOMACH

One of the main reasons for severe stomach problems in dogs could be worms. Worm infestation is a serious issue when it comes to puppies.
